

**THE ALBERTA FIGURE SKATING FOUNDATION PRESENTS:
2023 TRIPLE/QUADRUPLE GOLD AWARDS**

In order to receive this award, you must be a member of the Alberta Figure Skating Foundation for two full years, and a member in good standing by December 31, 2022(not to be confused with your Skate Canada membership). Membership is \$65.00 per family or \$40 for individual, information on becoming a member can be found on our website, www.albertafigureskatingfoundation.ca.

This is a once only lifetime award for a skater, only one award will be given either a triple Gold or a Quad Gold award.

Qualifications:

Triple Gold Award: Skater must have completed any three disciplines of Free Skate, Dance, Skating Skills, or Interpretive at the Gold Level.

Quadruple Gold Award: Skater must have completed all four disciplines of Free Skate, Dance, Skating Skills, and Interpretive at the Gold Level.

Skaters have up to 3 years after completing their last gold level to qualify for either their Triple or Quad award from the Foundation, the cut off year is 2020

Presentation of this award will be at the Skate Canada: Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Annual Awards Banquet in June (place, date to be announced). If for some reason the Awards Banquet is cancelled awards will be mailed.

The completed form must be RECEIVED no later than midnight of March 1, 2023
