The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation has been honoring and recognizing skaters that have achieved Triple/Quad Gold levels in skating for over 49 years. In order to receive this reorganization, skaters must be a member of the Alberta Figure Skating Foundation for two full years, and a member in good standing by December 31, 2024(not to be confused with your Skate Canada membership). Membership is \$65.00 per family or \$40 for individual, information on becoming a member can be found on our website, www.albertafigureskatingfoundation.ca.

This is a once only lifetime opportunity for a skater, only one award will be given either a triple Gold or a Quad Gold award. **Qualifications:** 

<u>Triple Gold Award</u>: Skater must have completed any three disciplines of Free Skate, Dance, Skating Skills, or Artistic at the Gold Level.

<u>Quadruple Gold Award</u>: Skater must have completed all four disciplines of Free Skate, Dance, Skating Skills, and Artistic at the Gold Level.

Skaters have up to 2 years after completing their last gold level to qualify for either their Triple or Quad award from the Foundation, the cut off year is 2023.

Skaters will be recognized of this achievement at the Skate Canada: Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Annual Awards Banquet in June (place, date to be announced).
